- Opportunities to undertake workshops to help with skill development

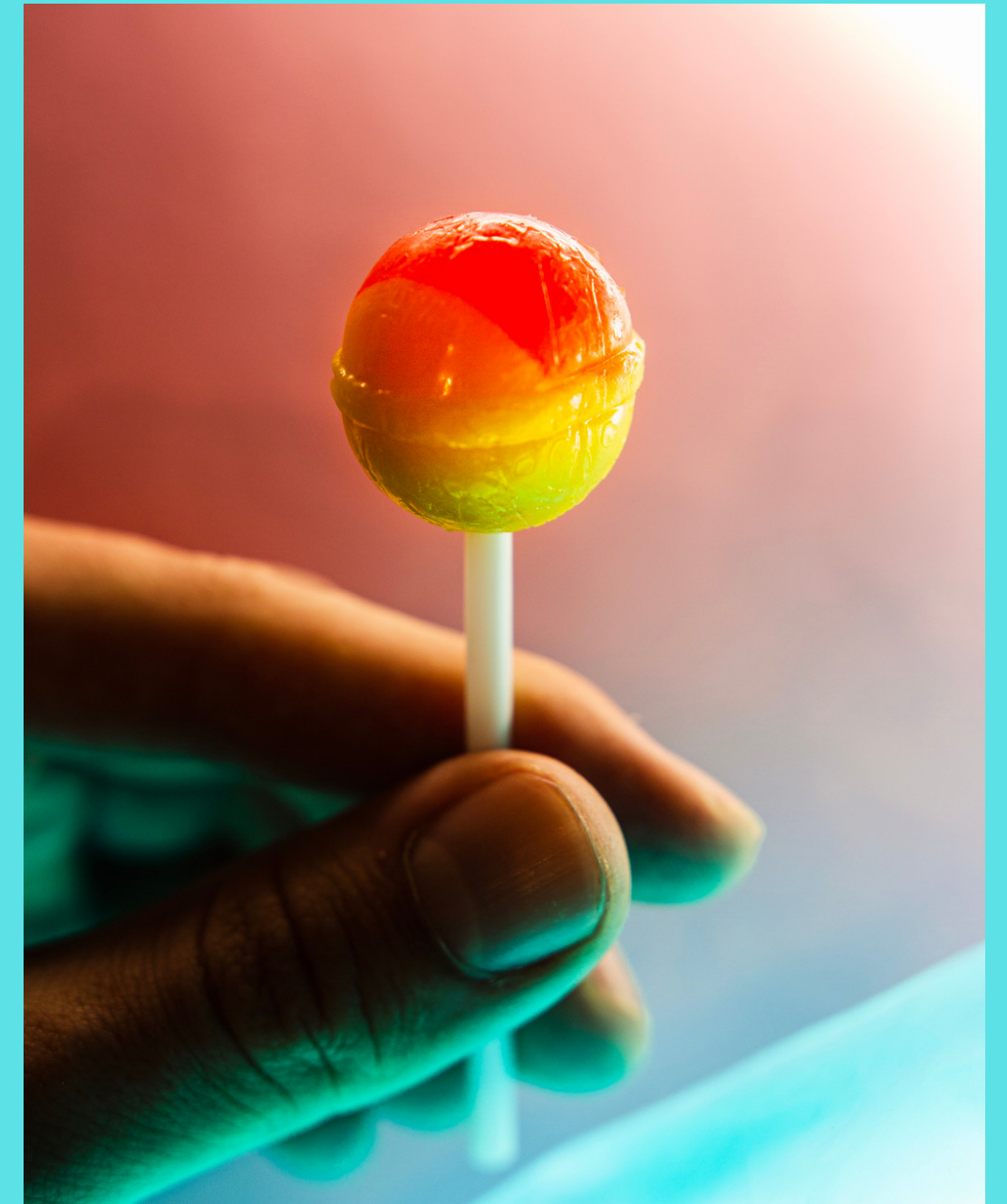


# Lollipop Moments
